- To help the Police in preventing or resolving critical incidents where the Police response is likely to have a significant impact on the confidence in the community;
- Highlight issues of concern within diverse communities and seek to escalate these actions

This partnership aims to assist with building public confidence, improving local policing performance and accountability. IAG members are volunteers who are representatives of the Nottinghamshire communities and passionate about improving local policing performance.

Last month, we informed you, our members, about the Independent Advisory Groups (IAG) with some more information.



Since this was sent out, the numbers of members who wished to received updates from the selected groups has increased dramatically and we can't thank you enough!


